



## **Reading This Week:**

10/5/20 – Jesus appears to the disciples in Galilee – John 21:1-13

One night, after Jesus had been raised back to life, Peter and some of the other disciples were near the Sea of Galilee. Peter said, "I'm going fishing!" The others said, "We will go with you." They went out in their boat. But they didn't catch anything that night.


Early the next morning Jesus stood on the shore, but the disciples did not realise who he was. Jesus shouted, "Friends, have you caught anything?" "No!" they answered. So he

told them, "Let your net down on the right side of your boat, and you will catch some fish." They did, and the net was so full of fish that they could not drag it up into the boat.

Jesus' favorite disciple told Peter, "It's the Lord!" When Simon heard that, he put on the clothes that he had taken off while he was working. Then he jumped into the water and went ashore. The other disciples stayed in the boat and dragged in the net full of fish.

When they got out of the boat, they saw some bread and a charcoal fire with fish on it. Jesus told his disciples, "Bring some of the fish you just caught." Simon Peter got back into the boat and dragged the net to shore. In it were one hundred fifty-three large fish, but still the net did not rip.

Jesus said, "Come and eat!" But none of the disciples dared ask who he was. They knew he was the Lord. Jesus took the bread in his hands and gave some of it to his disciples. He did the same with the fish.








# Create

Questions to think about:


1. Does this story seem familiar to you? (Something very similar happens earlier in the Gospels)



