




Reading This Week:

30/8/20 - The cost and reward of following Jesus - Matthew 16:21-28

Last Sunday we heard how Peter recognised Jesus as the Messiah, God's chosen one. But Peter didn't understand what that meant ...

21 Jesus began telling his disciples what would happen to him. He said, "I must go to Jerusalem. There the nation's leaders, the chief priests, and the teachers of the Law of

Moses will make me suffer terribly. I will be killed, but three days later I will rise to life." 22 Peter took Jesus aside and told him to stop talking like that. He said, "God would never let this happen to you, Lord!" 23 Jesus turned to Peter and said, "Satan, get away from me! You're in my way because you think like everyone else and not like God." 24 Then Jesus said to his disciples: If any of you want to be my followers, you must forget about yourself. You must take up your cross and follow me. 25 If you want to save your life, you will destroy it. But if you give up your life for me, you will find it. 26 What will you gain, if you own the whole world but destroy yourself? What would you give to get back your soul? 27 The Son of Man will soon come in the glory of his Father and with his angels to reward all people for what they have done. 28 I promise you that some of those standing here will not die before they see the Son of Man coming with his kingdom





Questions to think about:


1. *Why do you think Jesus was cross with Peter?*


Loving God,


