



Reading This Week:

22/11/20 - Christ the King - Sheep and Goats - Matthew 25:31-46 (abbr)

Jesus said, 31 When I come in glory, I will sit on his royal throne.

32 Everybody will be brought before me, and I will separate them, just as shepherds separate their sheep from their goats. 33 I will place the sheep on his right and the goats on his left.


34 I will say to those on his right, “My father has blessed you! Come and receive the kingdom that was prepared for you. 35 When I was hungry, you gave me something to eat, and when I was thirsty, you gave me something to drink. When I was a stranger, you welcomed me, 36 and when I was naked, you gave me clothes to wear. When I was sick, you took care of me, and when I was in jail, you visited me.”

37 Then they will ask, “When did we give you something to eat or drink? 38 When did we welcome you as a stranger or give you clothes to wear 39 or visit you while you were sick or in jail?” 40 I will answer, “Whenever you did it for any of my people, no matter how unimportant they seemed, you did it for me.”

41 Then I will say to those on his left, “Get away from me! 42 I was hungry, but you did not give me anything to eat, and I was thirsty, but you did not give me anything to drink. 43 I was a stranger, but you did not welcome me, and I was naked, but you did not give me any clothes to wear. I was sick and in jail, but you did not take care of me.”

44 Then they will ask, “Lord, when did we fail to help you when you were hungry or thirsty or a stranger or naked or sick or in jail?” 45 I will say to them, “Whenever didn't help any of my people, no matter how unimportant they seemed, you didn't do it for me.”

46 Then Jesus said, “Those people will be separated from me for ever. But the ones who pleased God will have eternal life with me.”





Loving God,
